4)	Have you travelled internationally or outside your home area within the past 14 days? If so, where						
5)	Have you been caring for someone at home or been in contact with anyone that has contracted or displayed symptoms consistent with COVID 19?						
6)	Can you attest to the fact that you have been carrying out COVID19 best practices for at least 14 days.						
7)	Per CDC guidelines, it is required that you wear a face mask while inside a hiring hall facility and maintain six feet of distance from anyone else inside the facility. Please acknowledge that you understand these protocols.						
NOTES:							
1) If the answer is YES to any of questions 1 through 5, you will not be permitted to enter a hiring hall until you are at least 72-hour fever and symptom free, and/or at least 14 days symptom free from exposure history. Follow up with your doctor or public health facility as appropriate to be cleared and then submit a new completed questionnaire when you wish to return to a hiring hall facility.							
2	2) Your temperature will be taken upon entering a hiring hall. If your temperature is above 100.4° F, or if you are displaying COVID or flu-like symptoms, you will be denied entrance. With the use of a remote temperature gun, if the reading is 99 degrees or higher, you will be denied entry as that is the equivalent of 100.4 degrees on a standard oral thermometer.
